## SELECTION PROCESS for the Ma. Lourdes S. Bautista Lecture Series (MLSBLS) Speaker

(As approved by the LSP Board on 2 April 2024, via ZOOM)

## The Ma. Lourdes S. Bautista (MLSB) Lecture Series

- Established to honor a distinguished linguist, researcher, teacher, mentor, collaborator, leader, and pioneer, whose vision and perspectives provided better ways of understanding and doing linguistics in the Philippines and beyond;
- Established in April 2024 and is managed by the Department of English & Applied Linguistics (DEAL) and the Linguistic Society of the Philippines (LSP).
- 1. The recipient must:
  - a. have a doctorate degree in linguistics or related field;
  - b. have worked in the areas of interest of MLSB (Sociolinguistics, World Englishes, Corpus Linguistics, Language Teaching) as evident in their teaching and research;
  - c. have a publication in any of these aforementioned areas published in a reputable refereed journal, book chapter, or book (at least, in the last two years);
  - d. must not be a member of the LSP board at the time of nomination and lecture.
- 2. The recipient will receive:
  - a. An honorarium of PHP 10,000 from LSP;
  - b. a plaque and a certificate of recognition from DLSU-DEAL;
- 3. The paper:
  - a. must be in the areas of interest of MLSB, as mentioned;
  - b. must be relevant to the linguistic and language education scholarship in the Philippines;
  - c. must be research-based, or empirical, in nature;
  - d. preferably, will be published in PJL
- 4. The process of selection will go through:
  - a. LSP, in consultation with DEAL, shortlists potential lecturers;
  - b. The honoree, Dr. Ma. Lourdes S. Bautista, personally approves the lecturer.

\*The recipient of the MLSBLS will be notified through email by the President of LSP; \*The recipient will have to inform the board of their acceptance (or otherwise), at least, two weeks after the receipt of the letter.
